

## Tuition and Fees:

Application Fee \$100 (non-refundable)
Class reservation deposit \$500 (applied to Tuition at culmination of the program)

Tuition includes examination and certification fees only. Books needed for the program are the responsibility of the student. .

### Tuition Payment Plan options:

“Audit Student” Learning option: Students opting for “Audit Student” options will receive 10% reduction on the above “Tuition Plan installment” amounts in the Tuition Payment Plan options table. Please note that Audit Program will not receive course credits.

“Stand-alone Student” Learning option: Each class will cost \$600 for Stand-alone Student learning option.

First payment is due upon enrollment per the “Tuition Plan installment” amount for respective plan. Subsequent payment will be due for selected payment plan on half yearly, quarterly or monthly as applicable with no grace period. A US \$25.00 late fee will be charged for delayed payments.

All subsequent payments are due on the first day of the month after completion of the Payment Plan term. For example, a Half yearly payment is due on the first day after completing six months, a Quarterly payment is due on the first day after completing three months. Monthly payment is due on the first day of every month.

\*Students choosing Half yearly, Quarterly, Monthly payment plan will be required to complete and sign a Payment Agreement Contract upon enrollment.

Payments must be made by check or major credit cards only. All payments must be denominated in US Dollars. Notify the College administration one month before payment is due if there are any changes with your credit card on file.

American Institute of Ayurveda does not offer state or federal financial aid, educational loans or tuition scholarships to students at this time. Maintenance of a current and satisfactory account standing is required for continued Enrollment in the Program, graduation and for the issuance of transcripts. Students who lapse in their tuition payments will be dropped from Enrollment.
